

RESIDENTIAL REFUSE DISPOSAL INFORMATION

(Effective July 1, 2007)



GRAHAM ROAD LANDFILL

Hours: Tuesday thru Saturday, 8 am to 3:30 pm
(Large loads must arrive by 3:30 pm so they can be unloaded & scaled out by 4 pm)

Closed on Sunday and Monday

Permits: Residents must have a permit affixed to their vehicle. Permits are available for \$5 per calendar year at Graham Rd Landfill or at the Public Works Dept. on 9 Industry Road.

RESIDENTIAL DISPOSAL FEE SCHEDULE:

Residential Refuse Acceptable at \$80/ton (\$5.00 minimum fee):

Household Refuse: food waste, plastic film/wrappers, diapers, hard cover books, food contaminated items, etc. - material you could typically leave for curbside collection.

Furniture: mattresses, chairs, sofas, plastic encased appliances (stereo, keyboards), etc.

Construction and Demolition Materials: includes pressure treated wood, used sheetrock, plaster, reinforced concrete, insulation, ceiling tile, carpeting, flooring (tile and linoleum), etc.

Brush and Tree Limbs acceptable at no fee:

Brush, tree limbs (max 4' length, 18" max dia.), etc. (no stumps) from your personal residence.

Items Acceptable at \$60/ton (\$3.00 minimum fee):

Following items acceptable at the above rate, must weigh-in and dump separately:

Metals & White Goods: includes refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers, ranges, air conditioners, water heaters, microwaves, car rims, gas grills, propane tanks (keep/place separately), lawn mowers, metal desks/chairs, metal shapes (beams, pipes), etc.

Wood Waste: includes framing lumber, plywood, wood flooring/paneling, wood furniture, wood cabinets, wood doors, (nails okay), etc.

Asphalt Shingles: clean asphalt shingles free of drip edges, wood pieces, nails okay

Sheetrock: unused sheetrock / gypsum wallboard, NO paint or wallpaper.

Masonry: Concrete blocks, unreinforced concrete, bricks, etc.

NOTE: A wood swap shop area for clean lumber and an exchange area for used items (furniture, toys, etc) are available. You still will be charged the disposal fee for items placed in these areas.

Universal Waste items acceptable at no fee (dispose of separately):

Universal waste items are TV's, computer monitors (CRT type), mercury thermometers or thermostats w/mercury, fluorescent lamps and HID light bulbs. Keep separated and unbroken.

Used Motor Oil acceptable at no fee (dispose of separately, see attendant):

Used motor oil, free of gas (oil will be sniffed to insure gas-free). Car batteries are accepted.

Tires (unmounted only, that is, separated from rims):

Up to, but not including, eighteen-inch rim size:	\$ 2.00
Truck tires or eighteen inch rim and greater:	\$ 10.00
Heavy Equipment Tire (Min. charge of: \$25.00)	\$ 0.15 per pound

Unseparated acceptable items such as mixed wood waste and shingles accepted @ \$160.00/ton

Items Not Acceptable at this Facility:

Hazardous wastes to include asbestos, gasoline, solvents, paint (includes latex paint unless hard & solid), pesticides, fertilizer, etc.

Unbagged, separated leaves, grass clippings and yard waste are accepted at the site's Compost Area or at the Leaf Drop-Off Area at 9 Industry Rd.

Residential Disposal Permits

Residential disposal permits are required by all non-business residents of the town desiring to use the Graham Road Landfill. Permits are issued annually for a fee of \$5.00, except from September through December permit cost is \$3.00. All permits expire on December 31.

Proof of Town residency is required to obtain a permit. The permit is issued against the resident's motor vehicle registration with a Brunswick address. Residents without a motor vehicle registered in Brunswick must bring their motor vehicle registration with proof of residency, or Military ID to the Public Works Department (9 Industry Road) and submit proof of residency satisfactory to the Director to obtain a permit.

Permit Display

Permits must be placed at the top-left corner of the front passenger side door window of the vehicle for which the permit was issued. Permits are non-transferable, must not be carried loose or placed on another household vehicle. Should a resident use another household vehicle, or borrow a vehicle, they must provide the landfill gate attendant with the permit number assigned to their own personal vehicle or show their landfill permit receipt.

If you borrow a vehicle to bring your material to the landfill please bring your landfill permit receipt as well as identification so the Landfill Gate Attendant can verify your residency.

You can not have another person bring your material to the landfill under your permit.

You must be in the vehicle to qualify for the residential disposal fees.

Disposal Tip:

Metal, household refuse, refuse not suitable for curbside collection, brush, waste wood and masonry will need to be separately unloaded after first weighing in at the scale house. If you bring multiple type items (for example household refuse, metal, wood waste and brush) expect to make separate trips across the scale as each material will need to be weighed separately. To save time and extra work when unloading it is recommended you be sure to load your vehicle appropriately to allow unloading of each material independently.

Directions to Graham Rd Landfill

Turn onto River Rd at Pleasant St (Route 1) intersection traffic signal, (Riverside Cemetery is on the right as you enter & Saturn Dealership is on the left side of River Rd at Pleasant St):

1. Head north on River Road for 4.3 miles to Lisbon Road
2. Turn right onto Lisbon Road and go 0.9 miles to the Graham Road
3. Turn right onto Graham Road and go 0.4 miles to the landfill entrance.

(Blue and white directional signs to Graham Road Landfill are located at River Rd and Lisbon Rd, and at Graham Rd and Lisbon Rd.)
