NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS**

The Town Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. in the Town Council Chambers of the Brunswick Town Hall, 85 Union Street to consider the following:

- Item 1. The Town Council will consider hear public comments on an ordinance that would place a 180-day moratorium on development of 30 or more units in the Town of Brunswick without 20% of units deemed affordable housing, and will take any appropriate action.**
  
- Item 2. The Town Council will hear public comments an amendment that sets a \$500 fine in the Flavored Tobacco Ordinance, and will take any appropriate action.**
  
- Item 3. The Town Council will hear public comments regarding extending the distance of the “No Parking” zone at the intersection of Longfellow Avenue and Coffin Street, and will take any appropriate action.**
