



5th & 6th GRADE Maine Summit Basketball League Travel Basketball Tryouts



The Brunswick Parks & Recreation Department will enter a 5th grade boys and a 5th grade girls team, along with a separate 6th grade boys and a 6th grade girls team in the Maine Summit Basketball League. These travel teams are limited to Brunswick Residents and students of Brunswick Public Schools only. All games will be played on either Saturdays or Sundays beginning in November and the travel league will conclude in March following the Parks and Recreation Department's Youth Basketball Tournaments. Playoffs will take place in late February with championships the following weeks. One or two practices per week will be scheduled weeknights at the Recreation Center and/or the Harriet Beecher Stowe School. Player flexibility is required for this league.

The cost to participate in the league is \$125 for players who are selected. There is no fee for try-outs, but it is mandatory for players to attend the tryouts if they wish to play! Try-out dates and times are listed below.

Transportation to and from games will be the responsibility of parents. Parents willing to car-pool must provide the Parks and Recreation Department with a copy of their driver's license, vehicle registration, and proof of insurance.

Uniforms will be assigned to registered players prior to the first game. Players who have not registered and paid are not eligible to play, and will not be assigned a uniform until they do so.
