Family Halloween Window Painting



WHO: Resident and Non-Resident Families

WHAT: Show off your creativity with this Fall-themed window painting event!

WHERE: All along Maine Street, Brunswick!

WHEN: Families will gather on Sunday, October 23rd beginning at 11:00am to begin crafting their masterpieces! *Rain date for Window-Painting will be Wednesday, October 26th from 3-7p.m.

WHY: To enjoy the Halloween season with a fun family activity!

HOW: After making a preliminary Autumn or Halloween-themed sketch and having your sketch approved at the Recreation Department, your family may select a storefront window from the available list at the Recreation Center to paint! Paints and brushes will be provided on the day of the event. Don't delay, since there are a limited number of windows available!

FEE: \$20 Per Resident Family // \$27 Per Non-Resident Family

BEFORE YOU PAINT:

1. Make a preliminary sketch—The theme is Autumn or Halloween!
2. Have your sketch approved at the Recreation Department. The entry deadline is Wednesday, October 20th, but don't delay, since there are a limited number of windows available.
3. Once approved, your family may select a storefront window from the available list at the Recreation Center.
4. Compile a list of colors you will need. Available colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet, brown, white and black.
5. Paints will be made available Sunday, October 23rd, beginning at 11:00 a.m. at Senter Place on Maine Street until 3pm.

ON THE DAY OF THE CONTEST:

1. Participants may start painting their window as early as 11:00 a.m Sunday, October 23rd. Painting must be completed by 4 p.m.
2. Pick up your paint at Senter Place. You may return for paint during the event if you run out.
3. Bring your unbreakable, covered containers of paint, rags, water, stepladder, chairs, etc.
4. Participants' names will be placed on a card taped to the window. Look for your name before painting.
5. Spread a tarp or plastic sheet out on the sidewalk under the window prior to opening paints and beginning your masterpiece!
6. Use the paints provided to you from the Rec Department to paint your pre-approved sketch on your designated window.

AFTER YOU PAINT:

1. All painting must be completed on Sunday, October 23rd or, in the event of inclement weather, on the October 27th rain date. No exceptions.
2. Participants are encouraged to send a picture of the completed painting to Recprograms@brunswickme.org. Submitted pictures will be displayed on our Facebook page for the Facebook masses to ooh and ahh over.

HALLOWEEN WINDOW PAINTING CONTEST RULES, PAINTING CHECKLIST, AND REMINDERS!

WINDOW PAINTING RULES—

Register no later than Friday, October 21st at 12:00pm.

1. Paint and Brushes can be picked up at Senter Place on the day of the painting event.
2. Painting may not begin before 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, October 24th
3. Only paint provided by the Rec Department may be used and no additives, like glitter or thickeners, may be used.
4. There is a 4 foot limit on the height of your painting, which will be marked with tape on each window. Do not paint above this line.
5. Do not paint up to the very edge of the glass. Leave about two inches or more of unpainted window on both sides and the bottom edge.
6. Clean up your work space and surrounding area once your painting is complete. Return cleaned paint brushes to Senter Place before 4pm on Sunday or to the Recreation Center later on during the week.
7. Please leave at least a 6 foot area of the sidewalk for the public to be able to walk by the storefront.

WINDOW PAINTING CHECKLIST—

1. Wide mouth, unbreakable, covered containers/cans to hold paint-- 1 container for each color; extras for mixing colors, plus 1 for water. A couple gallons of clean water and a five gallon bucket works well for cleaning brushes.
2. Painting materials: paint, brushes, water containers and boxes to hold all of your equipment
3. Enough plastic to tape to the window and a tarp to cover sidewalk.
4. Enough rags to clean up after you've finished painting.
5. A step ladder, if needed.
6. 2 -inch removable painters' tape to give clean edges to painting

REMINDERS—

1. Take a photo of your painting when it is complete and perfect! Email to Recprograms@brunswickme.org to have your window shared on our website or on social media!
2. Take a moment to thank the merchant who is providing the window that you are painting— Without the merchant's support Window Painting would not be possible!
