



3RD-8TH GRADE YOUTH BASKETBALL LEAGUES

Youth basketball emphasizes the development of fundamental basketball skills and positive youth sports values such as teamwork, respect and sportsmanship. The program consists of one 1 hour week night practice and one Saturday game each week. Equal playing time is one of the goals of the program.

SCRIMMAGE/EVALUATION NIGHT

Your child is expected to participate in a Scrimmage/evaluation night at Brunswick Rec Center Gym on the date listed below. Players will be placed in groups and scrimmage in order for Recreation staff to assess the experience and skill level of players as they attempt to form balanced teams. Participation is important for the creation of fair and evenly balanced teams!

TEAM PLACEMENTS

You will receive communication from your child's coach regarding team placement and schedule prior to your first practice. Please indicate during registration if there is a potential conflict in your family's schedule that needs to be considered for team placement! Teams are put together based on careful evaluations to make them fair & balanced. Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate requests to change teams—once a player is placed on a team, there will be NO changes allowed.

Basketball League for Grades 5/6

Children in Grades 5-6 will play in separate gendered divisions and will have one 1 hour weekday practice and one Saturday game. Players will receive a reversible Jersey prior to the first day of games. If there are insufficient numbers to support two leagues, we will combine to form a coed league in order to give everyone an opportunity to play!

Basketball League for Grades 7/8

\$80 Brunswick Residents/ \$106 Non-Residents

Children in Grades 7-8 will be placed on combined teams and will have one 1 hour weekday practice and one Saturday game. Players will receive a reversible Jersey prior to the first day of games.
